David Pickworth serves as a transportation planner and engineer with VHB in Atlanta, Georgia. He has over seventeen years of experience specializing in travel demand modeling, traffic microsimulation, and traffic operations analysis. Mr. Pickworth's experience includes work on various transportation planning projects, corridor studies, traffic impact studies, and signal warrant analysis. He has worked extensively with Cube Voyager software for MPOs throughout the state of Georgia, including the ARC, and was instrumental in developing a three-tiered modeling process that links regional travel demand models to microsimulation analysis through the use of a mesoscopic dynamic traffic assignment model. David also has been involved in numerous traffic studies using the VISSIM microsimulation software to evaluate and visualize projects. He has a degree in Civil Engineering from the Georgia Institute of Technology and a music degree from Emory University.
