Dr. John R. McIntyre is founder and director of the CIBER, a national center of excellence since 1993 and a professor of international business management and international economic relations with joint appointments in the Scheller College of Business and the Sam Nunn School of International Affairs of the Georgia Institute of Technology, Atlanta, Georgia. He is also a senior fellow of the Center for Trade and International Security of the University of Georgia, Athens, Georgia.

He received his graduate education at McGill, Strasbourg and Northeastern Universities, obtaining his Ph.D. at the University of Georgia. Prior to joining Georgia Tech in September 1981, he was Research Associate for International Management at the Dean Rusk Center, University of Georgia School of Law. He has had work experience with multinational firms in the U.K. and Italy. Published in over 100 trade journal and research publications.

Dr. McIntyre has had extensive experience in designing and implementing international business education programs at the graduate, executive, and undergraduate levels. He has been the recipient of numerous government, foundation and private corporate grants to further the internationalization of business education and the integration of foreign language, technology, international affairs into the management curriculum.
